I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Griffiths all my property and effects real and personal whatsoever and wheresoever, chargeable with an annuity of (£60) Sixty pounds a year to my wife Mary Griffiths for her natural life, together with the house called Dolacanny in this parish for her residence during her lifetime. And I hereby appoint my said son Thomas Griffiths sole executor of this my will -
