

Executors

This is the last Will and Testament of me William Lloyd of Baynham Hall in the parish of Michaelchurch-on-Currow in the County of Radnor Shires, of which I appoint my own Hugh Lloyd and Thomas Griffiths of Flintsham Court, Executors. I devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate unto and to the use of the said Hugh Lloyd and Thomas Griffiths their heirs executors and administrators, Upon trust, that is to say, the said executors as soon as possible after my death are hereby directed to divide my whole estate amongst my five sons in the following manner, - the whole estate to be divided into five equal parts, and from the part or share given to my own James Lloyd of Brecknock two hundred pounds to be deducted, and fifty pounds of which sum to be added to the share of my own William Lloyd, then the remainder One hundred and fifty pounds to be redivided among my other four sons viz: William, Hugh, John & Charles. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand the 8th day of June One thousand eight hundred and eighty five.

Signed by the said William Lloyd as and for his last will in the presence of us present at the same time who at his request in his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses.
